BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Chapter 28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended SECTION 1. 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 3 read as follows: 4 "§28- Silver alert program. (a) The department of the 5 attorney general, with the cooperation of each respective 6 county's police department, local broadcasters, and other relevant and appropriate state and county agencies, shall 7 8 develop and implement a statewide silver alert program to be 9 activated on behalf of a missing senior citizen in the 10 appropriate county. To the greatest extent possible, the silver 11 alert program shall be integrated with the minor abducted in 12 life-threatening emergency/America's broadcast emergency response (MAILE/AMBER alert) program. 13 14 (b) A silver alert shall be issued if the following 15 criteria are met: 16 (1) A county police department receives a credible report
