BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part XI, to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§291C-</u> Parking in front of mailboxes. In any county
5	with a population of 500,000 or more, the stopping, standing, or
6	parking of vehicles in front of a mailbox that faces a roadway
7	and to which the United States Postal Service delivers mail is
8	prohibited from Monday through Saturday between the hours of
9	7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.; provided that this section shall not
10	apply to postal delivery vehicles."
11	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
