SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS TO
CONVENE A DENTAL ASSISTANT WORKING GROUP TO DEVELOP AND
RECOMMEND CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DENTAL ASSISTANTS.

1 WHEREAS, the licensure or certification of professionals in
2 the service industry helps to build consumer confidence and
3 trust in the services they receive; and
4

5 WHEREAS, proper certification of dental assistants is
6 necessary to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of the
7 State's citizens; and
8

9 WHEREAS, Hawaii is a part of a small group of states that
10 does not require dental assistants to be certified; and
11

12 WHEREAS, oral health experts should determine the criteria
13 necessary to create a regulatory framework that allows dental
14 assistants to grow in their profession while also ensuring
15 patient safety; now, therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature
18 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of
19 Representatives concurring, that the Department of Commerce and
20 Consumer Affairs is requested to convene a dental assistant
21 working group to develop and recommend certification
22 requirements for dental assistants in the State; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested
25 to consist of the following members:

- 27 (1) The Director of Commerce and Consumer Affairs or the
28 Director's designee, who shall serve as chairperson of
29 the working group;

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested
 14 to submit a report of its findings and recommendations,
 15 including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later
 16 than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session
 17 of 2021; and

 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 20 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Commerce
 21 and Consumer Affairs; Director of Health; Chairperson of the
 22 Board of Dentistry; President of the Hawaii Dental Association;
 23 President of the Hawaii Dental Hygienists' Association; and Dean
 24 of Health Academic Programs at Kapiolani Community College.
