## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AND HEALTH EFFECTS OF FIFTH-GENERATION WIRELESS TECHNOLOGY.

WHEREAS, 5G refers to fifth-generation wireless technology 1 intended to provide faster and higher capacity transmissions to 2 carry the massive data load generated by smart devices, the 3 4 Internet of Things, robotics, artificial intelligence, driverless cars, and other machine-to-machine connections; and 5 6 WHEREAS, 5G uses spectrum in the existing Long-Term 7 Evolution frequency range, commonly known by the acronym LTE, 8 and also includes the higher millimeter wave frequencies never 9 before used for Internet or cell phones; and 10 11 WHEREAS, 5G relies on millions of new small cell antennas 12 that will be clustered lower to the ground and closer to homes 13 and schools; and 14 15 WHEREAS, on June 21, 2018, the Governor signed Act 49, 16 Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, which clears the way for 17 implementation of 5G in Hawaii by standardizing the process of 18 5G small cell deployments; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the increased radio-frequency radiation exposure 21 resulting from more towers being placed closer to the ground may 22 pose risks to the environment and health; and 23 24 25 WHEREAS, studies have found potential negative health effects associated with 5G wireless radiation; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the insurance industry may have placed exclusions 28 in policies to exempt damage caused by this technology and 29 certain manufacturers provide warnings to consumers regarding 30 the reception of devices using this technology; and 31 32

WHEREAS, input is needed from the technological and other 1 2 communities as well as persons involved with developing 5G 3 technology; and 4 5 WHEREAS, a study is warranted to examine the advantages and risks associated with 5G technology, with a focus on the 6 7 environmental impact and potential health related effects; now, therefore, 8 9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature 10 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of 11 12 Representatives concurring, that the Department of Health is 13 requested to conduct a study on the environmental and health effects of evolving 5G technology; and 14 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is 16 17 requested to submit a report of its findings to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular 18 Session of 2021; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 21 22 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and 23 Director of Health. 24 25 26 OFFERED BY: Maine R.g.
