SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND
TOURISM AND DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES
TO CONDUCT A COST ANALYSIS STUDY REGARDING CONSOLIDATING
WEST HAWAII STATE OFFICES INTO ONE COMPLEX.

1 WHEREAS, there are various state offices operating in
2 various locations in west Hawaii; and

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4 WHEREAS, state offices not dependent on location can be
5 moved into one convenient area and consolidated at a single
6 location for purposes of cost effectiveness and efficiency; and

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8 WHEREAS, the consolidation of state services in a single
9 central location will improve services; now, therefore,

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11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature
12 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of
13 Representatives concurring, that the Department of Business,
14 Economic Development, and Tourism and the Department of
15 Accounting and General Services are requested to conduct a cost
16 analysis study regarding consolidating the state offices in west
17 Hawaii into one complex; and


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19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Business,

21 Accounting and General Services are requested to submit a report
22 of their findings and recommendations, including any proposed
23 legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior
24 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2021; and

 3 of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; and Comptroller
 4 of Accounting and General Services.




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
