SENATE RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE RACETRACK OR RACEWAY PARK ON OAHU AND REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM; AND THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO FACILITATE AND APPROVE ITS DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that auto racing has a rich 1 history in the State, with drag racing on the island of Oahu 2 3 dating back to the early 1950s; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Hawaii Raceway Park provided motor sports enthusiasts a legal venue to race from 1962 until its closure in 6 7 2006; and 8 9 WHEREAS, in the past thirty years, the State and City and County of Honolulu, through the use of state and county capital 10 improvement funds, have subsidized and supported the development 11 of recreational facilities such as multi-purpose gymnasiums, 12 13 arena venues, skateboard parks, swimming pools, a commercial driver's license training area, soccer fields, basketball 14 courts, shooting ranges, archery ranges, baseball fields, 15 football fields, a football stadium, tennis courts, dog parks, 16 17 volleyball courts, beach volleyball courts, botanical gardens, and golf driving ranges and courses; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, for the past forty years, county parks programs from the County of Hawaii, County of Maui, and County of Kauai 21 have provided raceway park facilities at closed airfield land 22 23 granted to the various counties by the military; and 24 25 WHEREAS, through the use of such lands, the public has at least one raceway park or racetrack to provide drivers a legal 26 and controlled alternative to racing on public streets and 27 28 highways; and 29





WHEREAS, the Honolulu City Council unanimously approved 1 2 Resolution No. 18-73, which finds that the need for an Oahu 3 raceway park or racetrack is urgent, longstanding, and a matter 4 of public safety; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 18-73 directs the City's 7 Administration to take certain actions to facilitate development 8 of a racetrack or raceway park on Oahu, including but not 9 limited to making a determination on whether there are cityowned properties that may be a suitable site; and 10 11 12 WHEREAS, no alternative site for a racetrack or raceway park has been identified on Oahu since the closure of Hawaii 13 14 Raceway Park in 2006; now, therefore, 15 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, that this body 17 urges the Department of Parks and Recreation of the City and 18 19 County of Honolulu to enter into a public-private partnership with a credible, well-vetted, non-profit organization in good 20 business standing, with a verifiable history of positive 21 22 community benefit and service to develop a proposal for the 23 design, financing, construction, and operation of a racetrack facility; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Public Safety 26 27 and Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism are requested to facilitate and approve the development of a 28 29 motor vehicle racetrack or raceway park; and 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 31 32 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Public Safety; Director of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; Mayor 33 of the City and County of Honolulu; Chairperson of the Honolulu 34 35 City Council; and Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation of the City and County of Honolulu. 36 37 38 39 OFFERED BY:
