Status Report: Food Distribution Program

Pursuant to Act 9, which provides that "beginning July 15, 2020, a monthly report that details all allocations be submitted to the governor and legislature", OCS provides the following status update on the Food Distribution Program established by Act 9, SLH 2020 Part XVII, Section 34.

- Total Dollars Appropriated, Disbursed and Expended to Date. Act 9, SLH 2020 Part XVII, Section 34 appropriated \$5,000,000 to the Office of Community Services (OCS) to be used for a public-private partnership to provide food assistance to families in need. As of October 31, 2020, a total of \$2,837,868.91 has been expended, approximately 57% of the total budget. Of that total, \$2,629,084.31 was for food expenses and \$208,784.60 was for distribution expenses.
- Programs/Services or Other Purchases that Have Resulted from the CARES Funds. Funds have been used to reimburse food banks across the state for food and distribution expenses such as shipping and packing.
