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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 302L-1.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3           "(c) Except for the superintendent of education, directors  
4 of state departments, president of the University of Hawaii,  
5 chief executive officer of Kamehameha Schools, and the executive  
6 director of the Hawaii Association of Independent Schools, or  
7 their designees, the members of the board shall serve staggered  
8 terms as follows:

9           (1) The representative of center-based program providers  
10 shall serve a two-year term;

11           (2) The representative of family child care program  
12 providers shall serve a three-year term;

13           (3) The representative of family-child interaction  
14 learning program providers shall serve a three-year  
15 term;

16           (4) The representative of philanthropic organizations that  
17 support early learning shall serve a two-year term;



- 1 (5) The representative from a head start provider agency  
2 shall serve a three-year term;
- 3 (6) The representative from the Hawaii Early Intervention  
4 Coordinating Council shall serve a three-year term;
- 5 (7) The parent representative shall serve a two-year term;
- 6 (8) The representative from the Hawaii chapter of the  
7 American Academy of Pediatrics shall serve a two-year  
8 term;
- 9 (9) The representative of home-visiting program providers  
10 shall serve a three-year term;
- 11 (10) The representative of Hawaiian medium early learning  
12 providers shall serve a two-year term; provided that  
13 the prohibition against serving more than two  
14 consecutive terms not to exceed eight consecutive  
15 years pursuant to section 26-34(a) shall not apply to  
16 the representative of Hawaiian medium early learning  
17 providers' term limit; and
- 18 (11) The representative of the Hawaii Council of Mayors  
19 shall serve a three-year term."

20 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval  
2 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2025.


