BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 202-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "[{}](b)[{}] Except for the ex officio members or their designees, the council members shall be appointed by the 4 5 qovernor for four-year staggered terms as provided for in 6 section 26-34. The governor shall appoint the chairperson of 7 the council. The council shall be constituted as provided by 8 P.L. 113-128 (29 U.S.C. 3111) of the following members: 9 The directors of labor and industrial relations[7 (1) 10 human services, and business, economic development, 11 and tourism; the superintendent of education; and the 12 president of the University of Hawaii or their 13 designees, as ex officio, voting members; 14 (2) The administrator of the division of vocational 15 rehabilitation, department of human services, as an ex 16 officio, voting member;
