- 1 SECTION 1. Act 39, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, provided
- 2 the University of Hawaii with express statutory authority to
- 3 enable and facilitate the deployment of university educational
- 4 and instructional resources, university managerial and fiscal
- 5 resources, and university personnel to promote the economic
- 6 health and diversification of workforce opportunities in the
- 7 State through the commercialization of inventions and
- 8 discoveries generated by or at the University of Hawaii.
- 9 Act 39, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, also included a repeal date
- 10 of June 30, 2021.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to make the innovation and
- 12 commercialization initiative program permanent by repealing the
- 13 sunset provision in Act 39, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017.
- 14 SECTION 2. Act 39, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, is amended
- 15 by amending section 3 to read as follows:
- "SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017[τ
- 17 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2021]."

- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.
