# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARENTAGE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require the  
2 department of health to convene a task force to recommend  
3 amendments to the Hawaii Revised Statutes to update existing  
4 parentage laws that reflect outdated, cisheteronormative  
5 concepts of families, parenthood, and parental rights.

6           SECTION 2. (a) The department of health shall convene a  
7 task force to recommend amendments to the Hawaii Revised  
8 Statutes to update existing parentage laws that reflect  
9 outdated, cisheteronormative concepts of families, parenthood,  
10 and parental rights.

11           (b) The task force shall include the following members:

12           (1) The director of health, or the director's designee;

13           (2) A representative from the department of the attorney  
14           general;

15           (3) A family court judge;

16           (4) A family law attorney;



1 (5) A representative of AF3IRM Hawaii; and

2 (6) Others as recommended by the task force.

3 (c) The task force shall submit a report of its findings  
4 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the  
5 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of  
6 the regular session of 2022.

7 (d) The task force shall be dissolved on June 30, 2022.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
