BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 421J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:


4 "§421J- Budget increases; board approval. Any budget
5 increases to members of an association shall be approved by at
6 least sixty per cent of the members of the board."
