
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 1, First Special Session Laws of Hawaii
2 2017, is amended by amending section 18 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 18. Notwithstanding any law, charter provision,
4 or ordinance to the contrary, in any county with a population
5 greater than five hundred thousand, in order to ensure the
6 appropriate use of state authorized funds to finance a locally
7 preferred alternative for a mass transit project, the president
8 of the senate and speaker of the house of representatives shall
9 each appoint two non-voting, ex-officio members to the board of
10 directors of the county's rapid transportation authority[-];
11 provided that, the non-voting ex-officio members shall not be
12 counted towards a quorum to which the board is entitled as the
13 number of members necessary to do business or the number of
14 members necessary to validate any act. The terms for each
15 member appointed pursuant to this section shall be determined by
16 the presiding officer who appointed them.

1 For the purposes of this section, "county rapid
 2 transportation authority" means any entity established by a
 3 county in the State with a population greater than five hundred
 4 thousand for the purpose of constructing, operating, or
 5 maintaining a locally preferred alternative for mass transit
 6 project and that receives moneys from a surcharge on state tax
 7 established pursuant to section 46-16.8, Hawaii Revised
 8 Statutes, transient accommodations tax revenues pursuant to
 9 section 237D-2(e), Hawaii Revised Statutes, or both."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
