
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-340, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3 "(c) Subsection (b) notwithstanding, if a candidate
4 committee does not file the [~~second~~] preliminary primary report
5 that is due ten calendar days before a primary, initial special,
6 or initial nonpartisan election, or the preliminary general
7 report[~~]~~ that is due ten calendar days before a general,
8 subsequent special, or subsequent nonpartisan election, or if a
9 noncandidate committee does not file the preliminary primary
10 report that is due ten calendar days prior to a primary,
11 special, or nonpartisan election, or the [~~second~~] preliminary
12 general report that is due ten calendar days prior to a general
13 election by the due date, the fine, if assessed, shall not
14 exceed \$300 per day; provided that, in aggregate:
15 (1) The fine shall not exceed twenty-five per cent of the
16 total amount of contributions or expenditures,
