
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 708-800, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "property" to read as
3 follows:

4 ""Property" means any money, personal property, real
5 property, thing in action, evidence of debt or contract, or
6 article of value of any kind[-], and includes property that is
7 stored in an electronic medium and is retrievable in a
8 perceivable form. Commodities of a public utility nature such
9 as gas, electricity, steam, and water constitute property, but
10 the supplying of such a commodity to premises from an outside
11 source by means of wires, pipes, conduits, or other equipment
12 shall be deemed a rendition of a service rather than a sale or
13 delivery of property."

14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16 begun before its effective date.



1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
