- 6 [which] that is over fifty years old[\pm] and meets the criteria
- 7 for being entered into the Hawaii register of historic places."
- 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
