A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 236, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2016 (Act 236), was enacted to close the
- 3 insurance gaps associated with transportation network companies
- 4 by establishing motor vehicle insurance requirements for
- 5 transportation network companies and transportation network
- 6 company drivers. Act 236 is scheduled to repeal on September 1,
- 7 2021.
- 8 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to repeal the
- 9 sunset date of Act 236 and make permanent the motor vehicle
- 10 insurance requirements for transportation network companies and
- 11 transportation network company drivers.
- 12 SECTION 2. Act 236, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016, is
- 13 amended by amending section 6 to read as follows:
- "SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 15 provided that section 2 of this Act shall take effect on
- 16 September 1, 2016[; provided further that this Act shall be
- 17 repealed on September 1, 2021]."



- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
