- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c), an
- 4 applicant for a renewal of a driver's license under this
- 5 section, or the reactivation of an expired license under section
- 6 286-107.5(a), shall appear in person before the examiner of
- 7 drivers and the examiner of drivers shall administer [such]
- 8 physical examinations as the state director of transportation
- 9 deems necessary to determine the applicant's fitness to continue
- 10 to operate a motor vehicle[-]; provided that the director may
- 11 enact emergency rules pursuant to section 91-3 to provide for
- 12 license renewals by mail or online."
- 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
