
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LICENSE RENEWALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c), an
4 applicant for a renewal of a driver's license under this
5 section, or the reactivation of an expired license under section
6 286-107.5(a), shall appear in person before the examiner of
7 drivers and the examiner of drivers shall administer [~~such~~
8 physical examinations as the state director of transportation
9 deems necessary to determine the applicant's fitness to continue
10 to operate a motor vehicle[-]; provided that the director may
11 enact emergency rules pursuant to section 91-3 to provide for
12 the renewal of a driver's license by mail or online for all
13 applicants without requiring a prior written request from the
14 applicant."

15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
