BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The auditor shall conduct an impact 2 assessment report, pursuant to sections 23-51 and 23-52, Hawaii 3 Revised Statutes, on the social and financial impacts of prohibiting health insurance companies from denying coverage for 5 certain types of health care treatments on the basis of gender 6 identity; provided that the policy, contract, plan, or agreement covers those treatments for purposes other than gender 8 transition. 9 (b) The auditor's report shall assess the social and 10 financial impacts of requiring the following health care 11 services related to gender transition treatments to be 12 considered medically necessary and not cosmetic: 13 (1) Hormone therapies; 14 (2) Hysterectomies;
