BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require the
- 2 auditor, with the assistance of the department of human

- 4 medicaid funds to provide coverage for the treatment for
- 5 homelessness.
- 6 SECTION 2. (a) The auditor, with the assistance of the
- 7 department of human services, shall conduct a study to assess
- 8 the impact of using medicaid funds to provide coverage for the
- 9 treatment for homelessness, including the costs to provide
- 10 coverage for the chronically homeless population in the State.
- 11 (b) The auditor shall submit findings and recommendations,
- 12 including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later
- 13 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
- 14 of 2022.
- (c) For the purposes of this Act, "treatment" or
- 16 "treatment for homelessness" includes:
