BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 132D-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) Except as provided in subsection (a) or as otherwise
4	specifically provided for in this chapter, any person violating
5	any other provision of this chapter, shall be fined not more
6	than [\$2,000] \$ for each violation. Notwithstanding any
7	provision to the contrary in this section, any person violating
8	section 132D-14.5 shall be fined at least [\$500] \$ and no
9	more than [\$2,000.] <u>\$</u> ."
10	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
11	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
12	begun before its effective date.
13	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
