- (c) A county or state agency may [apply to the board,
- 12 pursuant to this section, for chartering authority.] authorize
- public charter schools."
- 14 2. By amending subsection (h) to read:
- "(h) [This section] The provisions of subsections (e),
- 16 (f), and (g) shall not apply to [the commission.] those entities
- 17 listed in subsections (a), (b), and (c)."
