A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STREAM PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the board of land
2	and natural resources lacks rules for rendering decisions on
3	land dispositions that authorize water diversion from streams.
4	The legislature believes that public trust principles must guide
5	these decisions and must supersede commercial interests and that
6	the impacts of climate change are not sufficiently clear to
7	allow for any disposition lasting more than fifteen years.
8	The purpose of this Act is to:
9	(1) Prohibit the board of land and natural resources from
10	approving dispositions that authorize or have the
11	effect of authorizing the diversion of water from
12	streams, except under specified circumstances; and
13	(2) Require moneys collected through land dispositions
14	that authorize or have the effect of authorizing the
15	diversion of water from streams to be deposited into

the forest stewardship fund.

15		from an alternative source;
16	(4)	At all times no more than half of the water in a
17		stream is diverted from the stream;
18	(5)	The board concludes that the diversion will not
19		adversely impact the ecological, cultural,
20		recreational, and aesthetic values of the stream; and
21	<u>(6)</u>	All other legal requirements are met.
