

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MANSLAUGHTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that when an offender
- 2 chooses to drink to levels of intoxication and recklessly
- 3 operates a vehicle in a manner that results in the death of
- 4 another person, the offender has demonstrated reckless rather
- 5 than negligent behavior, which should result in a charge of
- 6 manslaughter.
- 7 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to specify that a
- $oldsymbol{8}$ person commits the offense of manslaughter if the person causes
- 9 the death of another person by recklessly operating a motor
- 10 vehicle with .08 or more grams of alcohol per two hundred ten
- 11 liters of breath or .08 or more grams of alcohol per one hundred
- 12 milliliters or cubic centimeters of blood.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 707-702, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 15 "\$707-702 Manslaughter. (1) A person commits the offense
- 16 of manslaughter if:

9		(B) With .08 or more grams of alcohol per one hundred
10		milliliters or cubic centimeters of blood;

13	SECT	ION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
14	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
15	begun bef	ore its effective date.
16	SECT	ION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	
18	SECT	TION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
