A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 127A-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) There is established [within the department of
- 4 defense] the Hawaii emergency management agency [-], to be
- 5 administratively attached to the department of defense. The
- 6 [adjutant general] administrator of emergency management shall
- 7 serve as the director of Hawaii emergency management and,
- 8 subject to the direction and control of the governor, shall
- 9 oversee the agency.
- 10 (b) There shall be an administrator of emergency
- 11 management who shall be appointed, and may be removed, by the
- 12 [director,] governor, and who shall have at least three years of
- 13 experience leading emergency management efforts at the local,
- 14 state, or federal level. The appointment shall not be subject
- 15 to the advice and consent of the senate. The administrator of
- 16 emergency management shall be the civilian head of and
- 17 responsible for the day-to-day operations of the agency. The

- 1 administrator of emergency management shall report to the
- 2 [director. The administrator of emergency management shall, in
- 3 the absence of the director, have all the duties and
- 4 responsibilities of the director, and shall report directly to
- 5 the] governor. The administrator of emergency management shall
- 6 not be subject to chapter 76."
- 7 SECTION 2. The administrator of the Hawaii emergency
- 8 management agency serving on the effective date of this Act
- 9 shall remain as administrator until a time as an administrator
- 10 is appointed by the governor pursuant to section 1 of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Hawaii Emergency Management Agency; Department of Defense; Administrator; Appointment

Description:

Specifies that the Hawaii emergency management agency is an administratively attached agency to, rather than established within, the department of defense. Makes the administrator of emergency management the director of the Hawaii emergency management agency and requires the administrator to report directly to the governor. Requires the governor to appoint the administrator of the Hawaii emergency management agency. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)
