## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 26-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) The department of defense shall be headed by a single
- 4 executive to be known as the adjutant general. The adjutant
- 5 general shall also be [the director of the Hawaii emergency
- 6 management agency as established in section 127A-3 and] the
- 7 director of homeland security.
- 8 The department shall be responsible for the defense of the
- 9 State and its people from mass violence, originating from either
- 10 human or natural causes.
- 11 The devolution of command of the military forces in the
- 12 absence of the adjutant general shall be within the military
- 13 establishment. The devolution of command of the Hawaii
- 14 emergency management agency in the absence of the adjutant
- 15 general, as director of the agency, shall be within the agency."
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 127A-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:



1 "(a) There is established [within the department of 2  $\frac{\text{defense}}{\text{defense}}$  the Hawaii emergency management agency [-], to be placed 3 within the department of defense for administrative purposes 4 only. The [adjutant general] administrator of emergency 5 management shall serve as the director of Hawaii emergency 6 management and, subject to the direction and control of the 7 governor, shall oversee the agency. 8 (b) There shall be an administrator of emergency 9 management who shall be appointed, and may be removed, by the 10 [director,] governor, and who shall have at least three years of 11 experience leading emergency management efforts at the local, state, or federal level. The appointment shall not be subject 12 13 to the advice and consent of the senate. The administrator of 14 emergency management shall be the civilian head of and 15 responsible for the day-to-day operations of the agency. The 16 administrator of emergency management shall report to the 17 [director. The administrator of emergency management shall, in 18 the absence of the director, have all the duties and 19 responsibilities of the director, and shall report directly to 20 the] governor. The administrator of emergency management shall 21 not be subject to chapter 76."

- 1 SECTION 3. The administrator of the Hawaii emergency
- 2 management agency serving on the effective date of this Act
- 3 shall remain as administrator until a time as an administrator
- 4 is appointed by the governor pursuant to section 2 of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.

## Report Title:

Hawaii Emergency Management Agency; Department of Defense; Administrator; Appointment

## Description:

Specifies that the Hawaii emergency management agency is established within the Department of Defense for administrative purposes only. Makes the administrator of emergency management the director of the Hawaii emergency management agency and requires the administrator to report directly to the governor. Requires the governor to appoint the administrator of the Hawaii emergency management agency. Effective 7/1/2022. (SD1)
