BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The public utilities commission shall
2	explore,	through its docket process, the feasibility of
3	relocatin	g above-ground electric transmission lines and
4	distribut	ion lines underground in high risk areas on the island
5	of Maui.	The assessment shall include but not be limited to:
6	(1)	The amortized costs of relocating above-ground
7		electric transmission and distribution lines
8		underground;
9	(2)	The risk of damage to the above-ground lines from
10		reasonably foreseeable high winds, wildfires, or other
11		natural adverse events that have historically
12		occurred;
13	(3)	The risk of damage to the above-ground and underground
14		lines from projected sea level rise in the area where
15		lines are located;
16	(4)	The risk posed to the surrounding area from damage to
17		the above-ground lines including but not limited to:

	(A) The potential for igniting witalities, and
2	(B) Road closures, especially roads that provide
3	access to critical infrastructure, such as
4	hospitals.
5	(b) The public utilities commission shall submit a report
6	to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
7	convening of the regular session of 2022. If relocating above-
8	ground electric transmission lines and distribution lines
9	underground in high risk areas on the island of Maui is deemed
10	feasible, the public utilities commission shall include proposed
11	plans and associated deadlines for this relocation in its report
12	to the legislature.
13	(c) For purposes of this Act, "high risk areas" includes
14	areas susceptible to frequent high winds and wildfires or areas
15	considered to be sea level rise exposure areas.
16	SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
