A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 302A-1106.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,

 is amended to read as follows:

 "\$302A-1106.5 Board of education; community [meetings.]
- 4 <u>forums</u>. [The board shall hold not less than one community
- 5 meeting annually in each county in] In addition to their regular
- 6 meetings, the board shall hold no less than six community forums
- 7 annually to discuss and receive input from the community on
- 8 public education and public library issues [-]; provided that the
- 9 board shall hold at least one community forum in each county.
- 10 The board chairperson shall designate board members to attend
- 11 [$\frac{\text{the}}{\text{each}}$ community [$\frac{\text{meetings.}}{\text{forum.}}$ These community
- 12 [meetings] forums shall not be held for the purpose of
- 13 formulating educational policy. The community [meetings] forums
- 14 shall be [exempt from sections 92-2.5, 92-7, 92-9, and 92-41;
- 15 provided that the board shall give written public notice of each
- 16 community meeting. The meeting notice shall indicate the date,
- 17 time, and place of the meeting, and shall be filed in the office

5	(1)	The board shall give written public notice that

11		persons shall be permitted to attend; provided that

16	(3)	The board shall afford all interested persons an
17		opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments, in
18		writing or in person, on any public education or
19		public library issue at each community forum;
20	(4)	No commitment relating to a vote on a matter is made
21		or sought at any community forum; and

1	(5) At the next duly noticed meeting of the board, the	
2	board members shall report their attendance and the	
3	matters presented and discussed at each community	
4	forum."	
5	SECTION 2. At any public meeting properly noticed pursuant	
6	to chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the board of education	
7	shall include an open forum at the end of its meeting agenda to	
8	afford all interested persons an opportunity to present oral	
9	testimony on any matter not on the agenda; provided that the	
10	testimony is related to matters over which the board of	
11	education has supervision, control, jurisdiction, or advisory	
12	power.	
13	SECTION 3. The board of education shall report to the	
14	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of	
15	the regular session of 2022 on its efforts to amend its policies	
16	to include an open forum at the end of its meeting agenda to	
17	afford all interested persons an opportunity to present oral	
18	testimony on any matter not on the agenda.	
19	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
20	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	
21	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.	

Report Title:

Board of Education; Public Meetings; Oral Testimony; Community Forums

Description:

Requires the board of education to hold no less than six community forums annually, with at least one forum in each county. Requires the board to include an open forum for public comments on non-agenda items. Requires a report to the legislature on implementing open forums. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD2)
