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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

PART I

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to:

- (1) Repeal or reclassify certain non-general funds of the University of Hawaii pursuant to the recommendations of the auditor in auditor's report no. 20-03; and
- (2) Transfer authority to the chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Hilo to expend funds from the conference center revolving fund.

PART II

SECTION 2. The purpose of this part is to reclassify the community colleges special fund as a revolving fund.

SECTION 3. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to part V, subpart D, to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

"§304A- Community colleges revolving fund. (a)  
Section 304A-2003 notwithstanding, there is established a  
community colleges revolving fund to receive, disburse, and



1 account for funds of programs and activities of the community  
2 colleges, including but not limited to off-campus programs,  
3 summer session programs, overseas programs, evening sessions,  
4 study abroad, exchange programs, cultural enrichment programs,  
5 and consultative services that help make available the resources  
6 of the community colleges to the communities they serve.

7 (b) The revolving fund may include deposits from:

8 (1) The University of Hawaii tuition and fees special fund  
9 established in section 304A-2153;

10 (2) Tuition, fees, and charges for affiliated  
11 instructional, training, and public service courses  
12 and programs; and

13 (3) Fees, fines, and other money collected for:

14 (A) Student health;

15 (B) Transcript and diploma;

16 (C) Library;

17 (D) Facility use;

18 (E) Child care;

19 (F) Auxiliary enterprises;

20 (G) Alumni; and

21 (H) Other related activities."



SECTION 4. Section 304A-2162, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is repealed.

SECTION 5. All unencumbered balances remaining in the community colleges special fund repealed by section 4 of this Act shall lapse to the credit of the community colleges revolving fund established pursuant to section 3 of this Act.

PART III

SECTION 6. The purpose of this part is to transfer authority to the chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Hilo to expend funds from the conference center revolving fund.

SECTION 7. Section 304A-2272, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

**"[+]§304A-2272[+] Conference center revolving fund; University of Hawaii at Hilo. (a)** There is established the conference center revolving fund for ~~[the]~~ conference center ~~[program in the college of continuing education and community service of]~~ programs conducted by the University of Hawaii at Hilo. All fees, charges, and other moneys collected in



1 conjunction with the conference center [~~program~~] programs shall  
2 be deposited in the revolving fund. The [~~dean of the college of~~  
3 ~~continuing education and community service~~] chancellor of the  
4 University of Hawaii at Hilo or the chancellor's designee is  
5 authorized to expend funds from the revolving fund for all costs  
6 associated with conducting conferences, seminars, and courses by  
7 the conference center [~~program~~] programs, including but not  
8 limited to expenses for honoraria, hotel and room rentals, food  
9 and refreshment, printing and mailing, airfare and per diem,  
10 [~~leis~~] lei, rental of audiovisual equipment, and conference  
11 supplies and materials.

12 (b) The chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Hilo  
13 shall submit a report to the legislature no later than twenty  
14 days prior to the convening of each regular session on the  
15 accounting of all income and expenditures within the revolving  
16 fund."

18 SECTION 8. The purpose of this part is to repeal various  
19 non-general funds.

20 SECTION 9. Section 304A-2156, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
21 repealed.

SECTION 10. Section 304A-2277, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is repealed.

~~["~~§304A-2277~~] Professional student exchange program revolving fund. (a) There is established a professional student exchange program revolving fund to be administered and expended by the Hawaii commission.~~

~~(b) The following moneys shall be deposited into the revolving fund:~~

~~(1) Principal and interest payments received as repayment of financial support from former or current participants of the professional student exchange program, pursuant to section 304A-3209; and~~

~~(2) Interest earned or accrued on moneys in the revolving fund.~~

~~(c) Moneys in the revolving fund shall be expended to:~~

~~(1) Support the professional student exchange program's activities, including the provision of financial support to participants at Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education receiver institutions; and~~



~~{2} Enforce the collection of delinquent obligations."}~~

SECTION 11. All unencumbered balances remaining in the University of Hawaii community services special fund repealed by section 9 of this Act and professional student exchange program revolving fund repealed by section 10 of this Act shall lapse to the credit of the general fund.

PART V

SECTION 12. The purpose of this part is to reclassify an administratively established fund.

SECTION 13. The university system bond and interest sinking fund revolving fund administratively established in 2002 is reclassified as a trust account.

PART VI

SECTION 14. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.
