

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GIFT REPORTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 84-11.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
3	"(d)	Excluded from the reporting requirements of this
4	section a	re the following:
5	(1)	Gifts received by will or intestate succession;
6	(2)	Gifts received by way of distribution of any inter
7		vivos or testamentary trust established by a spouse or
8		ancestor;
9	(3)	Gifts from a spouse, fiance, fiancee, any relative
10		within four degrees of consanguinity or the spouse,
11		fiance, or fiancee of such a relative. A gift from
12		any such person is a reportable gift if the person is
13		acting as an agent or intermediary for any person not
14		covered by this paragraph;
15	(4)	Political campaign contributions that comply with
16		state law;

(3)	impening available to or discribated to the public
	generally without regard to the official status of the
	recipient;
(6)	Gifts that, within thirty days after receipt, are
	returned to the giver or delivered to a public body or
	to a bona fide educational or charitable organization
	without the donation being claimed as a charitable
	contribution for tax purposes; [and]
(7)	Exchanges of approximately equal value on holidays,
	birthday, or special occasions[-]; and
(8)	Food and beverages with a total value of less than \$25
	provided as part of an informational meeting or
	presentation or goodwill event with persons not
	required to register as a lobbyist under chapter 97."

Gifts; Reporting Exemptions; Informational Meetings; Goodwill Events
