BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 "§291- Costs. Beginning July 1, 2022, all costs 5 associated with the statewide parking program for persons with 6 disabilities shall be appropriated from the accessible parking 7 special account established under section 348F- ." 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 348F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 10 and to read as follows: Accessible parking special account. (a)

- 11 including antique motor vehicles, except as otherwise provided
- 12 in sections 249-4, 249-6, and 249-31.5, shall be subject to a
- 13 [\$45] \$46 annual vehicle registration fee; provided that
- 14 electric vehicles and alternative fuel vehicles shall pay an
- 15 annual vehicle registration surcharge fee of \$50, which shall be

- 4 with the county fee. The state registration fee shall be deemed
- 5 delinquent if not paid with the county registration fee. The
- 6 respective counties shall collect this fee together with the
- 7 vehicle registration tax collected for the county and shall
- 8 transfer the moneys collected under this section to the State.
- 9 (b) In addition to the annual vehicle registration
- 10 surcharge fee, for each annual motor vehicle registration fee,
- 11 the director shall deposit \$40 into the state highway fund

Report Title:

Disability and Communications Access Board; Disability and Communications Access Board Special Fund; Accessible Parking Special Account; Motor Vehicle Registration Fees

Description:

Requires the disability and communications access board to establish within the disability and communications access board special fund an accessible parking special account. Authorizes the use of moneys in the special account to cover the costs to administer the statewide parking program for persons with disabilities. Increases the annual vehicle registration fee for vehicles and motor vehicles other than electric and alternative fuel vehicles. Requires that \$1 of the annual vehicle registration fee be deposited into the special account.
