
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTIETH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$59,000,000 or so much
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2021-2022
for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
the fortieth representative district, as follows.

1. To be expended by the department of education:

A. Ilima intermediate school,

Oahu

Design and construction of sixth
grade building.

Total funding	\$35,000,000

B. Campbell high school, Oahu

Design and construction to
complete athletic master plan.

1 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
7 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
