- deposited in an established post office within the prescribed time, duly stamped, registered, or certified, and directed to the state ethics commission; provided, however, in the event it is not received, a duplicate of the statement shall be promptly filed upon notice by the state ethics commission of its nonreceipt; and
- (2) Shall be <u>permanently</u> preserved by the state ethics commission [for a period of four years from the date of filing]; and shall constitute part of the public records of the state ethics commission."
