
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ETHICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 97-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§97-4 Manner of filing; public records.** All statements
4 required by this chapter to be filed with the state ethics
5 commission:

6 (1) Shall be deemed properly filed when delivered or
7 deposited in an established post office within the
8 prescribed time, duly stamped, registered, or
9 certified, and directed to the state ethics
10 commission; provided, however, in the event it is not
11 received, a duplicate of the statement shall be
12 promptly filed upon notice by the state ethics
13 commission of its nonreceipt; and

14 (2) Shall be permanently preserved by the state ethics
15 commission [~~for a period of four years from the date~~
16 ~~of filing~~]; and shall constitute part of the public
17 records of the state ethics commission."

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
