
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ETHICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 97-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "**§97-4 Manner of filing; public records.** All statements
4 required by this chapter to be filed with the state ethics
5 commission:
- 6 (1) Shall be deemed properly filed when delivered or
7 deposited in an established post office within the
8 prescribed time~~[7]~~; duly stamped, registered, or
9 certified~~[7]~~; and directed to the state ethics
10 commission; provided~~[7, however,]~~ that in the event it
11 is not received, a duplicate of the statement shall be
12 promptly filed upon notice by the state ethics
13 commission of its nonreceipt; and
- 14 (2) Shall be ~~[preserved]~~ maintained by the state ethics
15 commission for a period of ~~[four]~~ six years from the
16 date of filing; and shall constitute part of the
17 public records of the state ethics commission."

3 SECTION 3 This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
