
- 1 SECTION 1. Section 329-130, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) After December 31,  $\left[\frac{2023}{7}\right]$  2021, a qualifying patient
- 4 shall obtain medical cannabis or manufactured cannabis products
- 5 only:
- 6 (1) From a dispensary licensed pursuant to chapter 329D;
- 7 provided that the cannabis shall be purchased and paid
- for at the time of purchase; or
- 9 (2) By cultivating cannabis in an amount that does not
- 10 exceed an adequate supply for the qualifying patient,
- 11 pursuant to section 329-122; provided that each
- location used to cultivate cannabis shall be used by
- no more than five qualifying patients.
- 14 After December 31, [2023,] 2021, no primary caregiver shall be
- 15 authorized to cultivate cannabis for any qualifying patient."
- 16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

#### Report Title:

Medical Cannabis; Authorized Sources; Qualifying Patients; Primary Caregivers

### Description:

Changes the date after which: (1) qualifying patients shall only obtain shall obtain medical cannabis or manufactured cannabis products from certain authorized sources; and (2) primary caregivers shall no longer be authorized to cultivate cannabis for any qualifying patient, from 12/31/2023 to 12/31/2021.

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
