HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII SCHOOL OF NURSING AND DENTAL HYGIENE TO CONDUCT AN ANALYSIS OF ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES.

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that there is a 1 physician shortage in the State, which often leaves rural 2 3 communities with challenges to health care access; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Legislature is currently looking at different legislation to expand the scope of practice for advanced 6 7 practice registered nurses; and 8 9 WHEREAS, according to the Hawaii State Center for Nursing, since 2009, the Legislature has passed twenty-two laws related 10 to the scope of practice of advanced practice registered nurses; 11 12 and 13 14 WHEREAS, the 2021 Legislature has or is considering five 15 measures related to expanding the scope of practice for advanced practice registered nurses in a variety of ways in Hawaii; and 16 17 18 WHEREAS, it is challenging to expand the scope of practice for advanced practice registered nurses without a holistic view 19 20 of what their scope of practice could and should be in Hawaii; 21 and 22 23 WHEREAS, there is a need to make clear distinctions to understand the differences between physicians and advanced 24 practice registered nurses and what both profession's scope of 25 practice in Hawaii should be; now, therefore, 26 27 28 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 29 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the Senate concurring, that the University of Hawaii 30
