## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

---

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, VIA THE BEHAVIORAL RISK  
FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF  
EDUCATION, VIA THE YOUTH RISK BEHAVIOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM,  
TO COLLECT INFORMATION ON THE SEX, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, AND  
GENDER IDENTITY AND GENDER EXPRESSION OF RESPONDENTS.

1 WHEREAS, major mental and physical health care professional  
2 associations recognize that being lesbian, gay, bisexual,  
3 transgender, queer or questioning, and intersex (LGBTQI) is part  
4 of natural variations that occur in sex, sexual orientation, and  
5 gender identity; and

7 WHEREAS, the Department of Health published reports in 2018  
8 and 2019 highlighting the issues facing lesbian, gay, bisexual,  
9 transgender, or queer or questioning (LGBTQ) children and youth  
10 in Hawaii, including higher rates of isolation, depression,  
11 suicidal ideations or attempts, substance use and misuse,  
12 homelessness, and sexual and intimate partner violence; and

13  
14 WHEREAS, to date, data collection efforts indicate a  
15 significant population of indigenous lesbian, gay, bisexual,  
16 transgender, and queer or questioning youth; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, the State relies on the Behavioral Risk Factor  
19 Surveillance System as a critical resource for monitoring the  
20 health of Hawaii's adult population; and

22 WHEREAS, the Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance System is a  
23 joint effort of the Hawaii Departments of Health and Education  
24 for monitoring the health of Hawaii's youth population; now,  
25 therefore,

27 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
28 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session



1 of 2021, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Health is  
2 requested, via the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System,  
3 and the Department of Education is requested, via the Youth Risk  
4 Behavior Surveillance System, to collect information on the sex,  
5 sexual orientation, and gender identity and gender expression of  
6 respondents; and  
7

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is  
9 requested to participate in the Behavioral Risk Factor  
10 Surveillance System; and  
11

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is  
13 requested to publish a detailed report on the results of the  
14 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System on its website every  
15 three years; and  
16

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is  
18 requested to include questions related to the sex, sexual  
19 orientation, and gender identity and gender expression of  
20 respondents in its Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System  
21 questionnaire; and  
22

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is  
24 requested to develop its own questions related to respondents'  
25 sex, sexual orientation, and gender identity and gender  
26 expression as part of the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance  
27 System questionnaire; and  
28

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is  
30 requested to publish a comprehensive report on the health of  
31 Hawaii's LGBTQI community every three years; and  
32

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is  
34 requested to include in this comprehensive report data collected  
35 from the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System; and

37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is  
38 requested to compare, in each of these reports, the prevalence  
39 of health-related risk behaviors, chronic health conditions, and  
40 use of preventive services between the LGBTQI population, and  
41 where possible LGBTQI sub-populations, and the general  
42 population; and

7 Safety, Chairperson of the Board of Education, Superintendent of  
8 Education, Chairperson of the Board of Regents of the University  
9 of Hawaii, and President of the University of Hawaii.
