HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CONVENING OF A WORKING GROUP TO DISCUSS THE ROLE OF THE AUTHORIZER, ITS RELATIONSHIP WITH CHARTER SCHOOLS, THE ACCOUNTABILITY FOR THE USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS, AND WHETHER OR NOT LEGISLATION IS REQUIRED TO EFFECTUATE ANY DESIRED CHANGES.

WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Public Charter School Commission 1 (Charter Commission) has faced questions on the role of the 2 authorizer and its relationship with charter schools; and 3 4 WHEREAS, it is unclear whether the unresolved questions 5 about the Charter Commission's authority should be addressed via 6 the Legislature through the enactment of laws or by 7 administrative rulemaking; and 8 9 WHEREAS, there is a need to clarify the purpose and intent 10 of charter school authorizers; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the need for public accountability of public funds 13 must be balanced with the authority for the charter school to 14 educate our keiki; now, therefore, 15 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 17 18 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the Senate concurring, that the following are requested 19 20 to convene as members of the Charter School Authorizers Working 21 Group: 22 The Chairperson of the Senate Education Committee, or 23 (1) 24 their designee, who shall serve as co-chair; 25 The Chairperson of the House Education Committee, or 26 (2) their designee, who shall serve as co-chair; 27 28

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Charter School Authorizers 1 Working Group is requested to meet in May, July, September, and 2 November in 2021; and 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Charter School Authorizers 5 Working Group is requested to submit a report of its findings 6 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 7 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 8 the Regular Session of 2022; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 11 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 12 13 Charter Commission, Executive Director of the Charter Commission, and Chairperson of the Board of Education. 14
