HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION, AND HAWAII EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO RECOMMEND TO THE LEGISLATURE HOW TO SUPPORT GREATER LOCAL PRODUCTION OF FOOD.

WHEREAS, Hawaii is susceptible to a variety of natural disasters, including hurricanes and tsunamis; and

WHEREAS, according to the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency, Hawaii has only approximately a three days' supply of food if the States' harbors are rendered inaccessible; and

WHEREAS, Hawaii has rich agricultural lands and near-perfect weather; and

WHEREAS, Hawaii sorely needs to diversify its economy; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the Senate concurring, that the Legislative Reference Bureau, in consultation with the Department of Agriculture, Department of Taxation, and Hawaii Emergency Management Agency, is requested to conduct a study to recommend to the Legislature how to support greater local production of food; and
