## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION TO DECLARE THAT THE COMMISSION DOES NOT SUPPORT DISCRIMINATION AND RIGHT OF ACCESS RESTRICTIONS BASED ON COVID-19 VACCINE STATUS OR IMMUNITY TEST RESULTS.

1 WHEREAS, any medical decision is a personal and sensitive  
2 choice; and

4 WHEREAS, any person may decline an invasive medical test  
5 for health, personal, or other reasons; and

6  
7 WHEREAS, vaccines of any kind, including those formulated  
8 for the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), are invasive  
9 medical tests; and

11 WHEREAS, numerous people have suffered adverse medical  
12 effects from invasive medical tests, including vaccines; now,  
13 therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
16 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
17 of 2021, that the Hawaii Civil Rights Commission is requested to  
18 declare that the Commission does not support discrimination and  
19 right of access restrictions based on COVID-19 vaccine status or  
20 immunity test results; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no person or entity in the  
23 State should:

25 (1) Provide to, or deny, an individual any disposition,  
26 service, financial aid, or benefit that is different  
27 from, or is provided in a different manner to, a  
28 disposition, service, financial aid, or benefit  
29 provided to a similarly situated individual having a  
30 different COVID-19 vaccine status or immunity test
