# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EFFECTIVE GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS.

## **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the coronavirus
 disease 2019 pandemic highlighted the need to modernize
 government to meet the urgent needs of the community. The
 pandemic has also highlighted the need for greater flexibility,
 responsiveness, transparency, and accountability in how
 government interfaces with and responds to the community.

7 The legislature further finds that many current structures and processes have hindered or challenged agencies in their 8 9 ability to responsively, promptly, effectively, and efficiently 10 provide the government services that the public demands. 11 Executive branch departments, particularly those at the 12 administrative and division levels, are often hindered in 13 modernizing and realigning their programmatic and staffing 14 structures because of the processes required to effectuate 15 organizational change, collectively known as a "program 16 reorganization" or "reorg".

1 The legislature finds that program reorganization can take 2 two years or more to complete and often is not approved until 3 long after the original intent has lapsed. The legislature 4 found during the response to the pandemic that these processes 5 prevented expeditious staffing and proactive adjustments that 6 were needed to quickly respond to community needs.

7 The legislature finds that time is of the essence to 8 support attempts by the agencies to restructure and realign 9 their programs to quickly and effectively meet the needs of the 10 community. The current economic downturn and budget shortfall 11 facing the State necessitates significantly more flexibility and 12 public accountability. Government programs must reorganize to 13 more effectively manage and maximize the use of scarce resources 14 to address the complex and growing needs of our communities.

15 The purpose of this Act is to establish a two-year 16 reorganization pilot project within the department of health, 17 beginning with the behavioral health services administration, to 18 shift and organize the department's functions, positions, and 19 funding to effectuate an organization that cost-effectively and 20 more efficiently provides needed services to the public.

consultation with the appropriate bargaining units,
with the assistance of the department of human
resources development, to address affected employees
and maintain, to the extent possible, the employees'
functions as reflected in their current positions and
current salaries.

8 The reorganization pilot project shall begin with the (d) 9 reorganization of the behavioral health services administration. 10 No later than twenty days prior to the convening of (e) 11 the regular sessions of 2022, 2023, and 2024, the department of 12 health shall submit a report to the legislature of its findings 13 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, 14 regarding the pilot project.

15 (f) The reorganization pilot project shall end on June 30,16 2023.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060;
provided that the reorganization of the behavioral health
services administration shall begin upon approval of this Act.
