- 9 upon checks issued by the comptroller; provided that departments
- 10 shall obtain the approval of the attorney general before payment
- 11 of any claim may be made.
- 12 SECTION 14. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
- 13 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
- 14 shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if
- 15 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,
- 16 as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
- 17 cases to which the statute applies.
- 18 SECTION 15. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of
- 19 the appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business
- 20 on June 30, 2022, shall lapse.

- 1 SECTION 16. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 2 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 3 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 4 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 5 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 6 of this Act are severable.
- 7 SECTION 17. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3021.
