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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

RELATING TO THE HAWAII FILM AND CREATIVE INDUSTRIES DEVELOPMENT  
SPECIAL FUND.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 201-113, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "**§201-113 Hawaii film and creative industries development**  
4 **special fund.** (a) There is established in the state treasury  
5 the Hawaii film and creative industries development special fund  
6 into which shall be deposited:

7           (1) Appropriations by the legislature;

8           (2) Donations and contributions made by private  
9 individuals or organizations for deposit into the  
10 fund;

11           (3) [~~Grants provided by~~] All grants, revenues, rents,  
12 fees, and charges received from governmental agencies  
13 or any other source; and

14           (4) Effective January 1, [~~2021,~~] 2022, all revenues, fees,  
15 and charges from the processing of the motion picture,  
16 digital media, and film production income tax credit  
17 pursuant to section 235-17.

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1 (b) The fund shall be used by the department to provide  
2 for:

3 (1) A program to provide seed capital for film, media, and  
4 creative industries intellectual property development  
5 projects for export, as determined by the department;

6 (2) Programs that expand the skills of the State's resident  
7 workforce in the film, media, and creative industries;  
8 [~~and~~]

9 (3) Marketing programs that attract business opportunities  
10 within the film, media, and creative industries in the  
11 State~~[ ]~~; and

12 (4) Repair, maintenance, and operation of public  
13 facilities managed by the department that support the  
14 film, media, and creative industries in the State."

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii film  
16 and creative industries development special fund the sum of  
17 \$500,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year  
18 2021-2022 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be  
19 necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the purposes of this  
20 fund.

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1           The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
2 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes  
3 of this Act.

4           SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6           SECTION 4. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect  
7 on July 1, 2021.

## JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Business, Economic Development, and Tourism

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII FILM AND CREATIVE INDUSTRIES DEVELOPMENT SPECIAL FUND.

PURPOSE: Expand the funding sources and the authorized uses of the Hawaii Film and Creative Industries Development Special Fund.

MEANS: Amend section 201-113, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: Act 228, Session Laws of Hawaii (SLH) 2019, renamed the Hawaii television and film development special fund as the creative film and media development special fund, and amended the uses of the fund to support creative intellectual property, film and media funding support within the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism.

This bill would serve to clarify language in Act 228, SLH 2019, to add an expenditure ceiling of \$500,000, to begin implementation of the program as outlined in Act 228, SLH 2019, and expand sources of funding to include grants, revenues, rents, fees and charges collected by the department.

An expenditure ceiling is necessary in order to expend what is collected from other revenue sources and allow the Department to effectuate the Act.
