RELATING TO THE AEROSPACE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 201-72.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is repealed.

~~["§201-72.5 Aerospace advisory committee. (a) There is established an aerospace advisory committee within the office of aerospace development of the department of business, economic development, and tourism for administrative purposes. The committee shall be composed of thirteen members appointed by the governor, as provided in section 26-34, except as otherwise provided in this section. Of the thirteen members:~~

~~(1) Three members shall be representatives of the aerospace industry. One member shall be appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the president of the senate, and one member shall be appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the speaker of the house of representatives;~~

~~(2) Three members shall be representatives of the aerospace industry in this State. One member shall be appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the~~

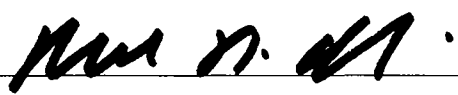

expenses, including travel expenses, incurred in the performance
of their duties as members of the committee.~~

~~(e) The committee shall convene for quarterly meetings in
the city and county of Honolulu; provided that any member who is
not a state resident may attend a meeting by teleconference.~~

~~(f) Administrative support to the committee, including the
development and dissemination of reports and advisory opinions,
shall be provided by the department of business, economic
development, and tourism."]~~
