
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 263-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§263-9 Dangerous flying a misdemeanor; penalty.** Any
4 aeronaut or passenger who, while in flight over a thickly
5 inhabited area or over a public gathering within the State,
6 engages in trick or acrobatic flying, or in any acrobatic feat,
7 or engages in or facilitates flying without a valid pilot
8 license, or flies, except while in landing or taking off, at
9 such a low level as to endanger the persons on the surface
10 beneath, or drops any object except loose water or loose sand
11 ballast, or paper handbills, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor
12 and punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or
13 imprisonment for not more than one year, or both.

14 For the purposes of this section, "pilot license" means a
15 certification or student certification issued or recognized by
16 the Federal Aviation Authority under title 14 Code of Federal
17 Regulations part 61."
