JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: HEALTH

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH.

PURPOSE: Authorize civil celebrants with no religious affiliation to solemnize marriages.

MEANS: Amend section 321-223, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: Current state law restricts marriage solemnization to individuals with religious affiliations. Active or retired judges are also authorized, but other secular officiants are not allowed. Authorizing "civil celebrants" with no religious affiliation to solemnize marriage would expand options for marriage.

Impact on the public: Expand options for marriage officiation.
