
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTION ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 329-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (b) to read:

4 "(b) The designated state agency shall determine those
5 schedules of controlled substances, classes of controlled
6 substances, [~~and~~] specific controlled substances that are
7 purportedly being misused and abused in the State[-], and opioid
8 antagonists used to reverse the effects of opioid overdoses. As
9 part of the controlled substance registration process, all
10 practitioners, except veterinarians, and pharmacies shall be
11 registered with the department to utilize the electronic
12 prescription accountability system. No identified controlled
13 substances or pharmacist-prescribed opioid antagonists may be
14 dispensed unless information relevant to the dispensation of the
15 substance or pharmacist-prescribed opioid antagonist is reported
16 electronically or by means indicated by the designated state



1 agency to the central repository established under section 329-
2 102, in accordance with rules adopted by the department."

3 2. By amending subsection (d) to read as:

4 "(d) Under the system:

5 (1) Information shall be reported in numerical format, not
6 less than once every seven days, including the
7 reporting of "zero" dispensing if no prescriptions for
8 designated controlled substances are filled, on the
9 filling of prescriptions for designated controlled
10 substances, pharmacist-prescribed opioid antagonists,
11 and the dispensing of drug samples by a licensed
12 practitioner; and

13 (2) Each dispenser shall maintain a record of such filled
14 prescriptions, including all information described in
15 subsection (c), for a period of five years. Each
16 dispenser shall keep these records available for
17 inspection and copying by the designated state
18 agency."

19 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

21 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
