A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CENTRAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 26-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) The department shall:
- 4 (1) Preaudit and conduct after-the-fact audits of the
5 financial accounts of all state departments to
6 determine the legality of expenditures and the
7 accuracy of accounts;
- 8 (2) Report to the governor and to each regular session of
9 the legislature as to the finances of each department
10 of the State;
- 11 (3) Administer the state risk management program;
- 12 (4) Establish and manage motor pools;
- 13 (5) Manage the preservation and disposal of all records of
14 the State;
- 15 (6) Undertake the program of centralized engineering and
16 office leasing services, including operation and
17 maintenance and lease buyback processing pursuant to



1 subsection (d) of public buildings, for departments of
2 the State;

3 (7) Ensure that state facilities are managed in accordance
4 with proper repair, maintenance, and sanitation,
5 including the establishment and communication of
6 sanitation procedures for the health and safety of
7 tenants and visitors;

8 ~~(7)~~ (8) Undertake the functions of the state surveyor;

9 ~~(8)~~ (9) Establish accounting and internal control
10 systems;

11 ~~(9)~~ (10) Under the direction of the chief information
12 officer, provide centralized computer information
13 management and processing services;

14 ~~(10)~~ (11) Establish a program to provide a means for
15 public access to public information and develop an
16 information network for state government; and

17 ~~(11)~~ (12) Assume administrative responsibility for the
18 office of information practices."
